Subj: Permanent change of station

1. Upon completion of duty under instruction in Class 3-63, Basic School on or about 5 June 1963 and when directed by the Commandant, Marine Corps Schools, you will stand detached from your present station and duties; will proceed and report to the Officer in Charge, Marine Corps Passenger Office, 100 Harrison Street, San Francisco, California for temporary duty and further transportation to Oahu, Hawaii. On arrival, you will report to the Commanding General, 1st Marine Brigade, Fleet Marine Force for duty.
2. Besides your proceed and travel time, you are authorized to delay 30 days in reporting to the Officer in Charge, Marine Corps Passenger Office, such delay charged as leave.
3. You are assigned the MOS indicated opposite your name effective on date of detachment.
4. Immunization is required in accordance with BUMEDINST 6230.1C before detachment.
